**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The redetermination of carriageway, footway and verges is a necessary part of the “South College Street Junction Improvements” project. The purpose of the project is to support the City Centre Masterplan aims to improve the public realm in the city centre. It will do this by providing additional road capacity to accommodate the rerouting of vehicular traffic arising from the implementation of public realm enhancements along Guild Street and Union Street. The corridor’s improved capacity and operation will also complement its position in the new roads hierarchy. The project will enhance infrastructure for walking and cycling (establishes sections of cycle track) along its length.
