THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (GLASHIEBURN SCHOOL AREA, BRIDGE OF DON, ABERDEEN) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202_

Aberdeen City Council, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, and having complied with the requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby makes the following order:-

Citation

1. This order may be cited as "The Aberdeen City Council (Glashieburn School Area, Bridge of Don, Aberdeen) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202_" and shall come into operation on ____.

20mph Speed Limit

2. No person shall drive, or cause or permit to be driven, any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on the lengths of road specified in the schedule hereto.
