ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (TWO MILE CROSS, ABERDEEN) (SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR – PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 202X

Aberdeen City Council, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, and having complied with the requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby makes the following order:-

1. Citation

This order may be cited as "The Aberdeen City Council (Two Mile Cross, Aberdeen) (School Keep Clear – Prohibition of Stopping) Order 202X" and shall come into operation on ____ 202__.

2. School Keep Clear- Prohibition of Stopping

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the north side of Two Mile Cross, Aberdeen, from a point 8 metres or thereby east of its junction with Pitmedden Road, eastwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby, between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm on any day, except Saturdays and Sundays.

3. Revocation

Upon the coming into effect of this order, any provision of any other order, with the exception of the Grampian Regional Council (Heavy Vehicles) (Overnight Parking Places, Aberdeen) Order 1987, made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, and existing at the time when this order comes into effect, which provision imposes a prohibition of waiting on the length of road specified in Article 2, is hereby revoked.
