THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (CAIRNGORM CRESCENT / CAIRNGORM GARDENS, ABERDEEN) (SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR – PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 202_

Aberdeen City Council, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, and having complied with the requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby makes the following order:-

Citation

1. This order may be cited as "The Aberdeen City Council (Cairngorm Crescent / Cairngorm Gardens, Aberdeen) (School Keep Clear – Prohibition of Stopping) Order 202_" and shall come into operation on _____ 202_.

School Keep Clear- Prohibition of Stopping

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the lengths of road in Aberdeen specified in the schedule hereto, between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm on any day, except Saturdays and Sundays.

Schedule

Cairngorm Crescent

West side, from a point 56 metres or thereby north-west of its junction with Arbroath Way, north-westwards for a distance of 60 metres or thereby.

Cairngorm Gardens

East side, from a point 105 metres or thereby south of its junction with Cairngorm Crescent, southwards for a distance of 32 metres or thereby.
